**Procedural Background**

On January 2, 2019, the Court issued a Decision and Order granting Robin Lazore's request for access to the decedent, Kerney Cole's, residence on [REDACTED]. Furthermore, the Court granted Francis Cole, decedent's heir, access to the decedent's home. Moreover, the Court ordered that Robin Lazore and Francis Cole make arrangements to change the locks at the decedent's residence or come to some other arrangement in order to allow them both access.

**Discussion**



The incident centered on a dispute regarding the decedent's heirs access to the residence located on [REDACTED].

**ORDERED** that Robin Lazore, Francis Cole, Bonnie Cole, Carrie Lazore, Nathan Cole, and Jeremy Cole appear on **January 14, 2019 at 9:00 a.m.** for a hearing on the heirs access to the decedent's residence located on [REDACTED].
