### PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On October 5, 2018, Thomas V. Herne filed a petition with the Saint Regis Mohawk Tribal Court requesting to be named the Administrator of the Estate of Moses H. Herne, his father. Moses H. Herne died on December 27, 1974. Thomas V. Herne submitted a certified family tree from the Saint Regis Mohawk Tribal Clerk's Office. Moses H. Herne predeceased his wife Catherine Herne.<sup>1</sup>

# **JURISDICTION**

Pursuant to the Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe's Probate Law, the Court "shall have personal jurisdiction to probate an estate when, at the time of death, (1) the deceased was either a Tribal Member or a person eligible for enrollment as a Tribal Member and the deceased resided or owned real or personal property located within the reservation." Furthermore, "[t]he Tribal Court shall have exclusive jurisdiction to probate real property located within the reservation." In the instant matter, Moses H. Herne, a tribal member, had an interest in real property. Thus, the Court possesses requisite jurisdiction.

## APPLICABLE LAW

The present action is governed by the Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe Probate Law (SRMT Probate Law).<sup>4</sup>

### **ANALYSIS**

Moses H. Herne owned Mose Cook Road. The SRMT Tribal Clerk's Office provided land records which demonstrate a chain of title. On October 10, 1968, Moses H. Herne purchased an approximately from Mose Cook. The purchase also came with a right of
