<b>Hazardous Chemical</b>	Better & Safer Alternative Cleaner
Aerosols	Use non-aerosol products
	• Deodorants -rolls, creams, sticks
	• Cooking sprays -cooking oils
	<ul> <li>Shaving cream -brush and shaving soap</li> </ul>
	Hair sprays -setting lotions, gels, pump sprays
	• Cleaners -pump sprays
Air	• Leave an open box of baking soda in the room
Freshener	• Set out a dish of vinegar
	• Add cloves, cinnamon, vanilla to boiling water, simmer for 5
	minutes
	• Use herbs or potpourri
All-Purpose Cleaner	• Mix 1 quart warm water, 1 teaspoon liquid soap, lemon juice,
<u>-</u>	and/or vinegar; make stronger according to the job
	Baking soda with water
Ant Control	• Pour a line of cream of tartar at a place where ants enter the house
	• Sprinkle red chili, paprika, or dried peppermint where ants enter
	Caulk or weather-strip entry points





Carpet Cleaner  Professional  Low Foaming Carpet Cleaner	<ul> <li>Use soap-based, non-aerosols cleaners</li> <li>Clean stains immediately with club soda</li> <li>Sprinkle cornstarch and vacuum</li> <li>Rub dry baking soda into grease</li> <li>Combine equal parts vinegar &amp; water to remove winter salt</li> </ul>
Chlorine Bleach	• Use sefer & less destructive dry bleech to whiten
<b>Disinfectant</b>	<ul> <li>Use safer &amp; less destructive dry bleach to whiten</li> <li>Use ½ cup borax in 1-gallon water</li> </ul>

FOR SMALL DRAINS GREASE TRAPS SEPTIC SYSTEMS Only Others Others Only Others Others Only Others Other	<ul> <li>Plunger or mechanical snake</li> <li>Handful of baking soda and ½ cup vinegar, followed by boiling water</li> <li>Use enzymatic biological drain cleaner</li> <li>To prevent clogging, flush drain weekly with boiling water</li> <li>To prevent clogging, use a strainer to keep hair, lint, etc. out of the drain</li> </ul>
Fabric Softener	• Rinse cotton & wool blankets with 2 cups white vinegar added to the washer
Floor Cleaner	<ul> <li>Mop with 1 cup white vinegar with 2 gallons of water</li> <li>Polish with club soda</li> </ul>
Furniture Polish OLISH	<ul> <li>Wipe with a mixture of 1 teaspoon lemon oil in 1-pint mineral or vegetable oil</li> <li>Try 3 parts olive oil, 1 part vinegar</li> <li>Try 1 part lemon juice, 2 parts vegetable oil</li> </ul>







Glue/Decal Remover	Soak in white vinegar
<b>Grout Cleaner</b>	• Use a toothbrush with either undiluted vinegar, 3 parts baking
	soda with one part water, toothpaste, or denture cream
Hair Colors	Use plant-derived rinses
Insecticides	Select pest-resistant plants
Mosquito	• Plant garlic cloves at 1-foot intervals in gardens
Insecticides Repellent	• Use traps or spray soaps
	• Blend 6 cloves crushed garlic, 1 minced onion, 1 tablespoon dried
	hot pepper, and 1 teaspoon pure soap in 1-gallon hot water; let sit 1-
4	2 days; strain; spray on plants
Insect Repellants	• Don't wear scented colognes, shaving lotions, or shampoos when
	outdoors
	• Use chamomile tea as a lotion
	Burn citronella candles, punk, or mosquito coils
Metal Polish	Brass - Worcestershire sauce
	Chrome - Apple cider vinegar or baking soda and a soft cloth

MFTAL POLISH CREAN	• Pewter - Rub with fine steel wool dipped in olive oil, wash in

Metal Polish	• Silver -Soak in 1-quart warm water with 1 teaspoon baking soda, 1
	teaspoon salt, and a piece of aluminum foil; or rub with ammonia
	and soft cloth, or soak in buttermilk or sour milk overnight







	• Stainless steel - Wash with 1-quart warm water and 3 tablespoons
	baking soda; rinse with hot water
Mildew/Soap Scum Remover	• Try 1/4 cup baking soda, ½ cup vinegar, and warm water

Oven Cleaner  OVEN  Cleaner  Cleaner  Cleaner	<ul> <li>Wipe up the oven spill as soon as possible</li> <li>Catch spills under the baking pan with a baking sheet</li> <li>Sprinkle salt and baking soda on a spill while the oven is still warm. Scour with steel wool and baking soda for baked-on grease, wipe with ammonia, let sit overnight; then scrub with baking soda</li> </ul>
<b>Scouring Powder</b>	Baking soda (do not use on aluminum) or salt
Stain Remover	• Make a paste of washing soda and water; club soda, lemon juice, and hot water
<b>Deodorant stains</b>	Rub lightly with white vinegar and launder as usual
Wine/coffee stains	Clean stains immediately with club soda
Coffee/tea stains	• Equal parts moist salt and vinegar; or baking soda solution of 3 tablespoons baking soda & 1-quart water
<b>Toilet Bowl Cleaner</b>	• Use baking soda and vinegar paste. Let sit for 2 hours, then scrub.
Window Cleaner	• Use ½ cup vinegar in 1-gallon warm water, use newspaper to dry glass
