### CLEANING AFTER ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE



**SOFT SURFACES:** such as carpeting and drapes use soap and water or appropriate cleaners for use on these surfaces. Launder if possible with warm water settings and dry completely.

**ELECTRONICS:** consider using a wipe-able cover. Follow any manufacturer's cleaning instructions. Or use alcohol-based wipes that contain at least 70% alcohol. Dry surfaces completely.


