

FAQ:

- **Are there outlets on the walking trail?**
 - No, there are no outlets or lighting on the walking trail.
- **Can dogs walk on the trail?**
 - Yes, they must remain on a leash. There are two dog waste receptacles with bags available along the trail.
- **Can we have bounce houses at the park?**
 - No, bounce houses are not allowed because they require electricity and water that causes flooding.
- **Can I play my own music in the lacrosse box?**
 - Yes, you can connect your device to the Bluetooth feature located on the second metal beam next to the Zamboni doors.
- **Are there outlets in the Lacrosse Box?**
 - Yes, there are 3 outlets available.
- **Is Generations Park open in the winter?**
 - Yes, the walking trail and sidewalks are plowed and salted throughout the winter season. The Lacrosse Box is converted into an ice rink and is open to the public for as long as weather permits. The restrooms are open on a limited winter schedule, M-F, 7-4.
- **Where can I get updates about Generations Park?**

- **What are the costs to reserve space at Generations Park?**
