**Deadline!** Your Answer must be served on the Petitioner at least **2 days** before the court date. If you do not serve and file your Answer by the deadline the court may approve the Petitioner's requests without hearing your side. CPLR 403 5. If the Court decides that the Tribal Court judgment should be recognized, the Court will direct that the Tribal Court judgment should be entered into the court records as a judgment of the Supreme Court of the State of New York.
